

FREMONT COUNTY COMMISSIONERS WORK MEETING MINUTES
September 29, 2009

Present for the meeting were Commissioners Paul Romrell, Skip Hurt, and Lee Miller.

Also attended by: Sheriff Len Humphries, Public Works Director Marla Vik, Planning & Building Administrator Kurt Hibbert, Park and Recreation Director Tamra Cikaitoga, Emergency Preparedness Coordinator Keith Richey, and Clerk Abbie Mace

Commissioners met with Representatives from Rocky Mountain Power Mark Stenburg, Glen Pond, Kelly Holt, and Claudia Condor to discuss the status of the Ashton Dam.

Mr. Stenburg presented a power point presentation on the status of the Ashton Dam. He gave a history of the dam. The dam was constructed from 1913 to 1916. He reviewed the performance of the dam to date. He reviewed the options to repair the dam. They discussed how this will affect the irrigators in this area. They discussed the ramifications to the boating and fishing in the area.

They also discussed the power plant in St. Anthony. If there is an issue with the commissioners trying to take over that plant. Mr. Stenburg explained that it is under a combined license with the Ashton Dam. The commissioners would like to stay in the loop on what will happen with the St. Anthony power plant.

Commissioner Paul Romrell made a motion to amend the agenda to discuss the replacement of the county owned bridge at 2200 East and 400 North. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion. A full voice vote was heard with all commissioners voting in favor. Commissioners made a site visit to the above mentioned bridge.
