

FREMONT COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MEETING MINUTES
May 26, 2011

Present for the meeting was: Commissioners Skip Hurt and Jordon Stoddard.

Also attended by: Clerk Abbie Mace, Deputy Clerk Cathy Jasinsky and Prosecuting Attorney Joette Lookabaugh

Commissioner Hurt called the meeting to order and welcomed those in attendance.

Fremont County Disaster Declaration

Keith Richey updated the commissioners on the flooding throughout the county. The weather service is expecting another inch of rain this weekend. The areas that were worked on last year are holding very well. The governor declared a state disaster for Bingham and Jefferson counties. Northern Idaho received a federal declaration. The county has 7000 sand bags and he has ordered more. There has been some flooding by the Del Rio Bridge. In light of declaring the disaster the county will not be charging for the sand bags.

Commissioner Skip Hurt made the motion to declare a Fremont County disaster for the next 90 days effective May 26, 2011. Commissioner Jordon Stoddard seconded the motion. A full voice vote was heard with all voting in favor.

The hinges on the back door for the sheriff's office need to be fixed prior to installing the electronic locks.

Executive Session IC 67-2345 (b)

Commissioner Skip Hurt made a motion to go into executive session pursuant to IC 67-2345 (b) to consider the evaluation, dismissal or disciplining of or to hear complaints or charges brought against a public officer, employee, staff member or individual agent or public school student at 11:25 a.m. Commissioner Jordon Stoddard seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with Commissioner Jordon Stoddard voting "Aye", and Commissioner Hurt voting "Aye". Commissioner Skip Hurt declared the meeting open at 11:49 a.m.
