

Fremont County Commissioners Meeting
Minutes
June 9, 2008

Present for the meeting were Commissioners Donald Trupp and Skip Hurt. Commissioner Romrell was excused.

Also present was Clerk Abbie Mace.

Clerk Abbie Mace gave the prayer.

Reporter Joyce Edlefsen led the pledge.

Billie Rogers asked permission to allow her son to ride his motorcycle on county owned property at the old stud mill property. Commissioners will have Attorney Karl Lewies put together a liability waiver for her to sign. The commissioners did not see any problem with this and will address these on a case by case basis.

Clerk Mace updated the board on the recount on the sheriff's race.

Commissioner Hurt updated the board on the Huntsman sand hauling to Teton County. Huntsman will have to have a surface mining permit. They were told we had damage to our county roads. They will give us repair money to repair our roads and they will repair the gravel road that was damaged.

Public Works Director Marla Vik presented her department reports:

Road & Bridge:

She presented more information on the glider truck kits she would like to purchase. She stated that the new trucks are having some problems. Madison County has purchased one and it decreases fuel efficiency by 30%. The kits are all new except for the rear ends. We are currently running mostly kits in our fleet. She also presented an updated capital improvement plan. Commissioners will hold this decision until Commissioner Romrell is in attendance.

Landfill:

She presented a piggy back bid for a dozer at the landfill. It will be a D6, replacing a D8. Commissioners will wait to make a decision.

Commissioner Hurt made a motion to go into executive session pursuant to IC 67-2345 (b) to consider the evaluation, dismissal or disciplining of, or to hear complaints or charges brought against, a public officer, employee, staff member or individual agent, or public school student; at 9:49 a.m. Commissioner Trupp seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with Commissioner Trupp voting I, and Commissioner Hurt voting I. Commissioner Hurt declared the meeting open at 10:03 a.m.

Commissioner Trupp made a motion to sign the maintenance agreement on the AS400 printer with MLTechnologies. Commissioner Hurt seconded the motion. A full voice vote was taken with both commissioners voting in favor.

Commissioner preformed the quarterly jail inspection.

There being no further business to come before the board meeting was adjourned.
